Foundation degrees

Health and Social Care FdSc

With 25% of the course achieved through work placements, you will have the opportunity to experience real-life practice environments as well as attending University one day per week. Taught by experienced staff from a range of professional health and social care backgrounds, you will have access to continual support at the University and on placement.

Early Years Foundation Degree
